A Complete Unknown (15)	Dir: James Mangold	USA	2024	140 mins
New York, 1961. Against the backdrop of a vibrant music scene and tumultuous cultural upheaval, an enigmatic 19-year-old from Minnesota arrives with his guitar and revolutionary talent, destined to change the course of American music. He forges intimate relationships with music icons of Greenwich Village on his meteoric rise, culminating in a groundbreaking and controversial performance that reverberates worldwide. Timothée Chalamet stars and sings as Bob Dylan in the electric true story behind the rise of one of the most iconic singer-songwriters in history.

Reunited with Mike Leigh for the first time since <i>Secrets & Lies</i> , the astonishing Marianne Jean-Baptiste plays Pansy, a woman wracked by fear, and prone to raging tirades against her husband, son, and anyone who looks her way. Meanwhile, her easy-going younger sister, played by Michele Austin, is a single mother with a life as different from Pansy's as their clashing temperaments.

Escaping post-war Europe, visionary architect László Toth (Adrien Brody) arrives in America to rebuild his life, his work, and his marriage to his wife Erzsébet (Felicity Jones) after being forced apart during wartime. On his own in a strange new country, László settles in Pennsylvania, where the wealthy industrialist Van Buren (Guy Pearce) recognizes his talent. But power and legacy come at a heavy cost...

<i>Wicked</i> , the untold story of the witches of Oz, stars Cynthia Erivo as Elphaba, a young woman, misunderstood because of her unusual green skin, who has yet to discover her true power, and Ariana Grande as Glinda, a popular young woman, gilded by privilege and ambition, who has yet to discover her true heart.
