A world-renowned but reclusive novelist (Bill Nighy), convinced he is about to die, summons his estranged sons to his home. But instead of seeking forgiveness for his countless mistakes, he instead reveals a truly unbelievable secret that brings his beloved ex-wife back into his orbit. With decades of resentment, jealousy and rage on the verge of spilling over, this splintered family is forced to face an inevitable reckoning, for better or for worse.				
Colony (15)	Dir: Sang-ho Yeon	South Korea	2026	123 mins
In this gripping new thriller from the writer/director of <i>Train To Busan</i> , a professor attends a conference in downtown Seoul only to witness it spiral into catastrophe when a rapidly mutating virus is unleashed. As the infected begin to transform, authorities seal off the entire facility and the survivors, barricaded inside the building, must contend with the mounting and unpredictable threat.

Michael Sarnoski's film adapts the 17th century folk ballad, <i>Robin Hood's Death</i> with a cast led by Hugh Jackman, Jodie Comer and Bill Skarsgård. Grappling with his violent past, Robin Hood finds himself gravely injured after a battle that he thought would be his last. He soon gets a chance at salvation when he meets a mysterious woman and a young girl.

The Doctor is returning home to Gallifrey with the remains of his arch-nemesis, the Master. Forced off course, the TARDIS arrives in San Francisco on New Year's Eve 1999. As the clock counts down to the start of the new millennium, can the Doctor stop his oldest enemy destroying all life on Earth? National Theatre Live: Les Liaisons Dangereuses (15)				
Lesley Manville (<i>Phantom Thread</i>) joins Aidan Turner (<i>Rivals</i>) in a striking staging of Christopher Hampton's adaptation of the classic novel. Marquise de Merteuil is a master in the art of survival. Alongside the magnetic Vicomte de Valmont, they turn seduction into strategy and weaponise desire. But when their alliance collapses into rivalry, the battle between them threatens to destroy everyone in their path.

Verdi's hugely popular <i>La Traviata</i> returns to the Sydney Harbour water stage featuring a breath-taking soaring 9 metre high, 3.5 ton chandelier covered in 10,000 shimmering Swarovski crystals. This glamorous production was captured on location on Sydney Harbour in 2021 in front of a sold out audience. <i>La Traviata</i> features timeless arias, lively choreography, beautiful costumes and spectacular fireworks.				
Pressure (Cert TBC)	Dir: Anthony Maras	UK/Fra/USA	2026	100 mins
In the tense 72 hours before D-Day, and with the fate of the free world hanging in the balance, <i>Pressure</i> follows General Dwight D. Eisenhower (Brendan Fraser) and Captain James Stagg (Andrew Scott) as they face an impossible choice – launch the largest and most dangerous seaborne invasion in history or risk losing the war altogether.				
To Kill a Mockingbird (PG)	Dir: Robert Mulligan	USA	1962	129 mins
In this adaptation of the famous novel, a white woman accuses a black man of rape in a Southern town. Though he is obviously innocent, the outcome of his trial is such a foregone conclusion that no lawyer will step forward to defend him - except Atticus Finch. His compassionate defence costs him many friendships but earns him the respect and admiration of his two motherless children. This QUAD Essentials screening will feature an introduction and post-film discussion.
