A Hard Day's Night (PG)	Dir: Richard Lester	UK	1964	87 mins
Meet the Beatles! Just one month after they exploded onto the U.S. scene with their Ed Sullivan Show appearance, John, Paul, George, and Ringo began working on a project that would bring their revolutionary talent to the big screen. <i>A Hard Day's Night</i> , in which the bandmates play cheeky comic versions of themselves, captured the astonishing moment when they officially became the singular, irreverent idols of their generation.				
After the screening on Saturday 1 August the QUAD bar will be taken over by Beatles Bandaoke. Warm up your vocal chords and belt out your favourite Beatles number backed by a live band.				
The screening on Sunday 2 August will be a QUAD Essentials screening and include an introduction and post-film discussion.

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The Furious (18)	Dir: Kenji Tanigaki	Hong Kong	2026	113 mins
The daughter of Wang Wei (rising martial arts star Miao Xie) is kidnapped and the corrupt police force have no interest in finding her. Wei sets out on a violent odyssey to ensure her return himself. He is aided by a journalist named Navin (Joe Taslim <i>The Raid, The Night Comes For Us</i>), whose wife has also vanished. Fuelled by a righteous fury – the two men ruthlessly track down the kidnappers and engage in a series of brutal and spectacular martial arts smackdowns. Ish (15)	Dir: Bart Schrijver	Holland	2025	131 mins
Set and filmed in the South Asian and Middle Eastern community in Luton, Ish follows 12-year-old best friends, Ish (Farhan Hasnat) and Maram (Yahya Kitana) who are navigating childhood against a backdrop of political tension and personal loss. After a police stop and search, where Maram is searched and Ish manages to run away, they wrestle to hold onto their friendship.

This is the rambunctious, ridiculous and totally true story of how the Minions conquered Hollywood, became movie stars, lost everything, unleashed monsters onto the world and then banded together to try and save the planet from the mayhem they had just created.				
Nostalghia (12A) S	Dir: Andrei Tarkovsky	Russia/Italy	1981	125 mins
4K Restoration. Andrei Tarkovsky's unforgettably haunting film, his first to be made outside Russia, explores the melancholy of the expatriate through the film's protagonist, Gorchakov, a Russian poet researching in Italy. Arriving at a Tuscan village spa with Eugenia, his beautiful Italian interpreter, Gorchakov is visited by memories of Russia and of his wife and children, and he encounters the local mystic who sets him a challenging task.

On The Sea (15)	Dir: Helen Walsh	UK	2026	111 mins
Jack has been married to Maggie for over half his life. He works as a Hand Raker on the mussel beds in North Wales alongside his younger brother, Dyfan, and Dyfan's three sons. Jack has always assumed that his own boy, Tom, will join the family business on leaving school but Tom's resistance to follow in his footsteps creates familial tension. Tensions are further inflamed by the arrival of an itinerant deckhand, Daniel.				
Turandot On Sydney Harbour (PG)				
This Handa Opera on Sydney Harbour production, directed by Chen Shi-Zheng, is known for its lavish sets, including a 25-meter dragon and a 20-meter pagoda, and its use of contemporary cinema and Chinese acrobatics.
