When wartime delivers profits for Joe, it comes at a price when his partner is charged with criminal manufacturing deals, and his eldest son goes missing in action. Will peacetime bring peace of mind, or will he be confronted by the consequence of his actions?

This Venice Best Film winner is a feature film in the form of a triptych. The three stories all concern the relationships between adult children, their somewhat distant parent (or parents), and each other. Featuring Cate Blanchett, Tom Waits, Adam Driver, Vicky Krieps and Charlotte Rampling.				
La Grazia (12A) S	Dir: Paolo Sorrentino	Italy	2026	133 mins
As his tenure as President of Italy nears its end, Mariano De Santis (Toni Servillo) faces wrenching decisions—both political and deeply personal. Amid these moral quandaries, he must confront his own conscience and seek guidance from those closest to him, including his confidante and daughter, Dorotea.				
Satori Screen: The Killer . Hard Boiled (18) - John Woo / Chow Yun-Fat Double Bill				
<i>The Killer</i> 1989 Hong Kong Dir: John Woo 111 mins - Ah Jong (Chow Yun-Fat) is an assassin who decides to retire after accidentally blinds a singer Jennie during a job. Deciding to do one final job to fund an operation to save her sight, he comes up against a determined cop.				
<i>Hard Boiled</i> 1992 Hong Kong Dir: John Woo 128 mins - Cop Tequila (Chow Yun-Fat) is working to bring down triad boss who maintains a stranglehold on Hong Kong's illegal gun trade. To do so he teams up with an assassin from a rival syndicate.				
The Magic Faraway Tree (U)	Dir: Ben Gregor	UK/USA	2026	115 mins
Polly (Claire Foy), Tim (Andrew Garfield) and their three children are relocate to the countryside. As they adapt to their new lives, the children discover a magical tree and its eccentric residents including treasured characters Moonface, Silky, Dame Washalot and Saucepan Man.

Frances Barber stars as Billie Trix – icon and complete disaster – in this bold and hilarious one-woman odyssey. From post-war Berlin to the New York art scene, from folk duos to disco comebacks, Billie Trix has done it all – often naked, usually high, and always on her own terms. Blending monologue with original songs by The Pet Shop Boys, <i>MUSIK</i> is a genre- defying exploration of fame, failure, and fierce individuality.				
Project Hail Mary (12A)	Dir: Phil Lord & Christopher Miller	USA	2026	156 mins
Science teacher Ryland Grace (Ryan Gosling) wakes up on a spaceship light-years from home with no recollection of who he is or how he got there. As his memory returns, he begins to uncover his mission: solve the riddle of the mysterious substance causing the sun to die out. He must call on his scientific knowledge and unorthodox ideas to save everything on Earth from extinction... but an unexpected friendship means he may not have to do it alone.				
Total Recall (15)	Dir: Paul Verhoeven	USA	1990	114 mins
Quaid (Arnold Schwarzenegger) is haunted each night by a dream that he is on Mars looking for the beautiful Melina (Rachel Ticotin). Quaid visits Recall who claim that they can help make his dream a reality through a trip in his mind with a hallucinogenic drug. But the experience has consequences and Quaid find himself in a pulse-pounding adventure.				
Exhibition On Screen: Turner and Constable (PG)				
Two of Britain's greatest painters, J.M.W. Turner and John Constable were also the greatest of rivals. Born within a year of each other, both used landscape painting to reflect the changing world. Tate Britain is bringing these two greats together for a groundbreaking exhibition, in London from November 2025 to April 2026, and Exhibition on Screen once again has exclusive access to bring their extraordinary art to the big screen				
Underland (12A)	Dir: Rob Petit	USA/UK	2026	79 mins
We know so little of the world beneath our feet. To most it is a place only of fear and darkness, though to a brave few it is one of knowledge and wonder to be found nowhere else. <i>Underland</i> is a cinematic documentary that voyages into worlds rarely glimpsed by human eyes. Beginning in the shallow soils beneath an old ash tree, the film follows several 'astronauts of the underworld'.
