<p><b>25th Anniversary Screenings.</b> The lonely 23-year-old Amélie (Audrey Tautou) decides to become an active member of her community by doing good deeds for those around her. When completing one such mission, she falls in love with a similarly shy collagist.</p>				
<b>Colours Of Time (15) S</b>	Dir: Cédric Klapisch	France	2025	126 mins
<p>In 2024 four cousins discover they share a mysterious family history. In 1895, their ancestor Adèle searches for her mother in Paris. She discovers a city on the cusp of modernity, bustling with new-found avant-garde creativity. As her descendants retrace her steps, they unravel Adèle's surprising past. The two timelines intertwine and collide, confronting the cousins' contemporary attitudes with life in late 19th century Paris.</p>

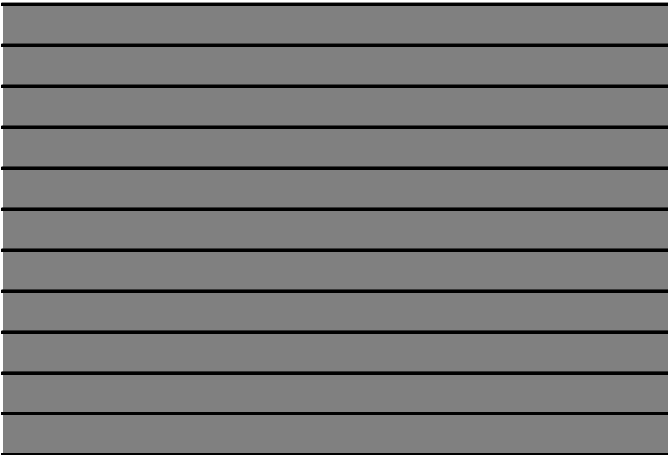
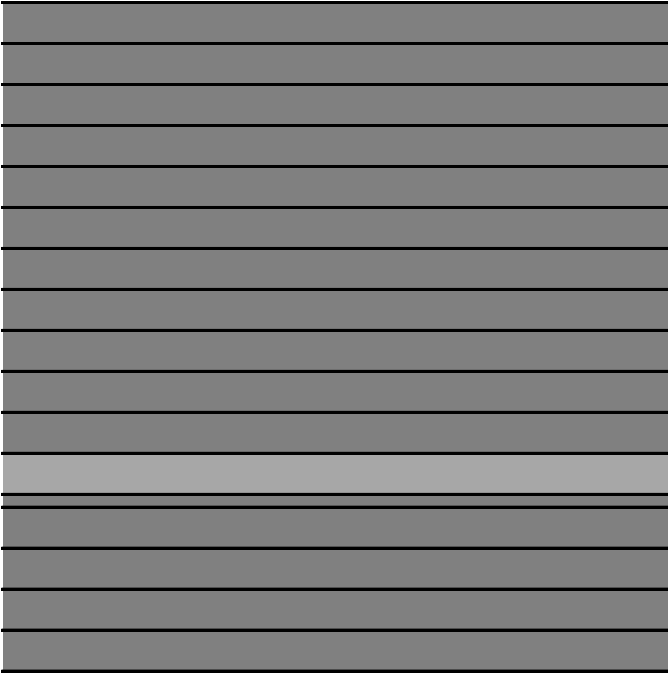
