<b>500 Miles (12A)</b>	Dir: Morgan Matthews	UK/Ireland	2026	101 mins
Finn (Roman Griffin Davis) and his live-wire younger brother Charlie (Dexter Sol Ansell) embark on an epic adventure from Yorkshire, over land and sea, to the Wild West coast of Ireland. With the free-spirited busker Cait (Maisie Williams) helping the young boys along the way, their destination is Dingle, County Kerry, and their estranged, beloved Grandfather (BAFTA-award winner Bill Nighy), who their parents haven't spoken to since the fateful events of the previous summer				
<b>Exhibition On Screen: David Hockney At The Royal Academy Of Arts (PG)</b>				
Widely considered Britain's most popular artist, David Hockney is a global sensation with exhibitions attracting millions of visitors worldwide. Originally released in 2017 this documentary saw Hockney entering his 9th decade and showing absolutely no evidence of slowing down or losing his trademark boldness. Featuring intimate and in-depth interviews with Hockney, the film focuses on two exhibitions held in 2012 and 2016 at the Royal Academy of Arts in London.				
<b>Angel's Egg</b>	Dir: Mamoru Oshii	Japan	1985	72 mins
In an underwater city, a young girl takes care of a large egg she holds carefully in her arms. A boy with a gun arrives in search of a bird he saw in his dream. At first, it seems as if feelings of sympathy are developing between the two. Forty years after the film's original release, Anime Limited is proud to present an all-new 4K restoration of the film, supervised by director Mamoru Oshii.

<b>Alphaville (12A) S</b>	Dir: Jean-Luc Godard	France	1965	99 mins
In a near future, the American secret agent Lemmy Caution (Eddie Constantine) travels to Alphaville posing as the journalist Ivan Johnson from the Figaro-Pravda newspaper. His mission is to find the missing agent Henry Dickson and to convince Professor von Braun to come with him to Nueva York. <b>This QUAD Essentials screening will include an introduction and post-film discussion.</b>				
<b>Birds Of War (15)</b>	Dir: Janay Boulos & Abd Alkader Habak	UK	2026	85 mins
A London-based Lebanese journalist and a Syrian activist and cameraman retrace their love story over thirteen years of war, revolutions and exile. Drawing on intimate personal archive, <i>Birds of War</i> asks what it means to build a life together in a world shaped by conflict.				
<b>Ghost Cat Anzu (PG) S</b>	Dir: Yoko Kuno / Nobuhiro Yamashita	Japan	2024	95 mins
Karin, 11 years old, finds herself abandoned by her father in a small Japanese town, where her grandfather, a monk, resides. Her grandfather asks Anzu, his jovial and helpful, although rather capricious, ghost cat, to look after her. As their spirited personalities collide, sparks fly—yet perhaps only in the beginning.				
<b>The Misfits (12A)</b>	Dir: John Huston	USA	1961	124 mins
Written by Arthur Miller and directed by John Huston, <i>The Misfits</i> is a touching and off-beat drama of broken-hearted cowboys and broken-down marriages, co-starring Clark Gable and Montgomery Clift as an aging cowboy and a rodeo-rocked bull rider, both with bittersweet memories of a west that's no longer wild. Infused with the promises of what could have been if she had been given more time to explore her skills as a dramatic performer, Marilyn Monroe delivers one of her very best performances.				
<b>Nirvana The Band The Show The Movie (15)</b>	Dir: Matt Johnson	Canada	2026	99 mins
Two struggling musicians are certain that playing a show at famed Toronto venue The Rivoli will lead to their dreams of musical fame and fortune being achieved. The duo's increasingly desperate attempts to book the gig lead to them being accidentally transported back in time to 2008...				
<b>The North (15)</b>	Dir: Bart Schrijver	Holland	2025	131 mins
Former best friends Chris (Bart Harder) and Lluís (Carles Pulido), who meet up after a decade to hike Scotland's West Highland Way and Cape Wrath Trail. Having taken the same 350-mile walk in their youth, the pair hope to rekindle their once-strong friendship by spending 30 days together in the majestic, raw beauty of the Scottish Highlands. But while Chris remains preoccupied with work and life back at home, Lluís is determined to finish the trail to prove he can still do it.

Pegeen Flaherty's life is turned upside down when a young man walks into her pub claiming that he's killed his father. Instead of being shunned, the killer becomes a local hero and begins to win hearts, that is until a second man unexpectedly arrives on the scene...				
<b>Rosebush Pruning (18)</b>	Dir: Karim Aïnouz	Italy/Germany	2026	96 mins
Underneath the Catalonian sun, a rich white American family lives in hedonistic isolation, seeking love and validation through one another, their designer wardrobes and pop music. When an outsider infiltrates the family, buried tensions surface and blood ties are severed. Callum Turner, Riley Keough, Jamie Bell, Elle Fanning and Pamela Anderson star.				
<b>Velvet Goldmine (15)</b>	Dir: Todd Haynes	UK/USA	1998	124 mins
Set in London in the early '70's during the emergence of the glam-rock scene- this film follows the rise of Brian Slade (Jonathan Rhys Meyers), a mythical rock icon. At the peak of his fame, Brian cruises the nightspots of New York and mixes with the likes of Ewan McGregor's Curt Wild, his spiritual twin and fellow glam rocker — until Brian disappears after a publicity stunt gone wrong.
